 - Obtain funds to hold Utah-Idaho Key Club District Events and Service Projects
 - Keep record and contact information of sponsors
 - Organize quarterly fundraising events for Utah-Idaho Key Club District
 - Correspond with Utah-Idaho Key Club Board
 - Committee Chair will attend all Utah-Idaho Key Club Board meetings, Fall Training Rally, 2012 Board Trainer, and 2013 District Convention.
 - All Committee Members and Committee Chair must attend all District Council Meetings
 - Committee members will uphold the objects of Key Club International and the Code of Conduct
 - All Committee Members must be a Key Club member of a Key Club in good standing
 - Work with Major Emphasis and District Project Committee
 - Implement sponsors with District Service Projects
 - Use sponsoring businesses to assist District Service Projects
- **Positions**
 - Committee Chair
 - 3–5 Committee Members
 - All positions are selected by the Utah-Idaho District Governor and Administrator based on an application process.
